OUTREACH CLASSES

The following classes are part of the 2024 USHJA Outreach Program. USEF and USHJA membership is not required to participate in an Outreach Competition or in any Outreach classes. Non-USEF and USHJA members will NOT be charged a Non-Member or Show Pass Fee. Riders and Trainers must be USHJA members at the free Outreach level or higher in order to be eligible for points toward year end awards. Hunter championships will be presented in each hunter section with the top four over fences earning under saddle points. Equitation championships will be presented in each equitation section with points counting equally for all classes. Combined section championships will be presented in each combined section with points counting equally for all classes. Ties broken by the most points over fences; if still tied, then most points in the equitation flat class.

SPECIAL CLASSES

Hunter Classics

Each classic will have a designated first-round class in which the last class of each division will be the designated class for the first round score of the classic. Exhibitors must enter the classic prior to the start of the first round class. Scratches are not permitted after the first round class has begun. Horses must have entered, shown, and completed the course in at least two of the respective hunter division classes over fences at this show. To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability and manners to count. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. To be shown over a course of approximately 10 jumps of height designated by qualifying division. The twelve horses with the highest scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over a different course. In the event of equality in the first round, all equal scores will return for the second round. Scores will be combined from the first round with the second round to determine overall winners. Trophy to first, ribbons through 12, and prize money divided as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

These competitions are governed and approved by the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. To the extent there is a conflict between the prize list and the USEF rules, USEF rules will prevail.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

REMINDER: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MANAGEMENT: Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management-their decision to be final. Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate or change judges and officials; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel. Management reserves the right to limit entries in a class. Refused entries will be returned.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: By signing the entry blank, the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Loungeur acknowledges that horseback riding, particularly jumping, is a dangerous activity and involves inherent risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases death because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance and expressly assumes all such inherent risks whether identified herein, in the entry blank, or in the Federation Rules and Regulations. or being present on the Show Ground Facility.

DAMAGE: Owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

ADHERENCE TO THE RULES: All individuals on the property are required to adhere to the rules mentioned in the prize list or as directed by the employees at the horse park. Trainers are all responsible for employees adhering to the rules. Violations will result in expulsion from the facility.

CLOSING OF ENTRIES: Entries close July 1, 2024

ENTRY PROCEDURES: One check per owner. Exhibitors may pay either by check or credit card (Visa or Mastercard). Exhibitors must enter online through showgroundslive.com.

Trainers and owners must leave a signed open check or credit card authorization for charges during the shows. Any accounts not closed each week will be charged \$100.

TRAINER SPLITS: OHDC allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until noon on the Friday of a show week. No exceptions will be made. Only items billed by the horse show directly can be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.

ALL ENTRIES WHICH ARE LATE WILL BE ASSESSED A \$75 LATE FEE.

Exhibitors will receive their prize money within 30 days after the Horse Show.

CREDIT CARDS: Exhibitors wishing to pay by credit card will be charged a 3% convenience fee. This fee is non refundable after the card has been charged.

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATIONS: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-11) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: Entries must be paid by draft payable in US Funds or check on Canadian US Dollar account. Canadian checks with US Funds written on the face of the check will not be accepted.

HIGH JUMPER NOMINATING FEE: Horses entered in any 1.20m or higher jumper class must pay a \$150 High Jumper Nominating Fee.

LOW JUMPING NOMINATING FEE: Horses entered in any jumper classes below 1.20m must pay a \$60 Low Jumper Nomination Fee.

HUNTER / EQ FEE: Horses or ponies entered in any hunter or equitation classes at this show

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES AND REFUNDS: Exhibitors canceling entries after the closing date shall forfeit their stall fee and the nomination fee. Credit card processing fees are non refundable once the card has been refunded. Refunds will be mailed within three weeks after the Horse Show.

RETURNED CHECKS/CREDIT CARDS: There will be a penalty of \$75 per check/credit card returned by the bank for any reason. No checks/credit cards will be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, the fees and penalty must be paid by Money Order, Cashiers Check or Cash before 4 PM the day before the Horse Show starts. In the event a check/credit card is returned after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913. No personal checks will be cashed at the Show. USEF FEE: For every horse participating in any competition recognized by the USEF, a \$23 USEF fee will be collected (\$15 shall be a Drugs & Medication fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3.

USHJA SUPPORT FEE: Every horse entered in any competition recognized by the USEF will be assessed a \$7.00 USHJA Support Fee. Outreach participants will be assessed a \$2.00 USHJA Outreach Fee.

Curfew and quiet times must be observed between 9pm and 5am (as required by GR1215.3 #033-22)

HORSE IDENTIFICATION: Horses are now required to have a back number attached to their neck or their rider when outside of their barn/tent (as per HJ106.2 #247-22).

NON SHOWING HORSES: NO NON SHOWING HORSES ACCEPTED. ALL HORSES/PONIES MUST COMPETE AT THE HORSE SHOW unless there are stalls available.

MEASUREMENT AND AMATEUR CERTIFICATION: All Small, Junior and Pony Hunters must possess and present a current Measurement Card to the show secretary before numbers may be picked up. If the cards are not available, MEASUREMENT WILL BE REQUIRED. Photocopies of current Amateur Certification of Junior Memberships may be included with entries or made available when picking up numbers.

MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction. Equitation classes not filling may be combined with the next age group. Notice will be given to exhibitors affected. Management reserves the right to start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class orders to facilitate time schedule and conditions.

COMBINED CLASSES & SECTIONS: Any class or section that does not have at least five entries 12 hours before the first class is scheduled (unless otherwise specified) will be combined.

STABLING: PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. Portable box stalls with doors on grass/dirt are provided. Shavings may be purchased. Stalls will be available for occupancy at 10:00 a.m. Sunday morning July 14 must be vacated Sunday, day July 21 unless staying for week 2. Horses arriving for week 2 may arrive after 12:00 on Monday, July 22 and must vacate but Sunday July 28 unless otherwise arranged with show management. Fee for box stalls for each show shall be \$325. Exhibitors do their own stall cleaning. Refunds after those dates will only be made if the stall is reissued to another entry.

SCHOOLING AND EXERCISE: No schooling will be allowed in the Show Rings.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HAUL-INS: Haul ins will be allowed with management approval.

3RV PARKING: Electricity and water will be provided on a first come first serve basis (limit of 28) for a fee of \$500.00 per week. Please send in RV Form (On Website: <https://www.oregonhighdesertclassics.org/rv-reservations>).

FOOTING: Competition rings are grass. Warm-up areas are grass and all weather footing. Hunter & Jumper Rings are 300 X 150, Grand Prix ring is 320 X 300.

DRESS: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is compulsory for rider in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / (SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

SHARPS: Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agent up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp dissable instruments.

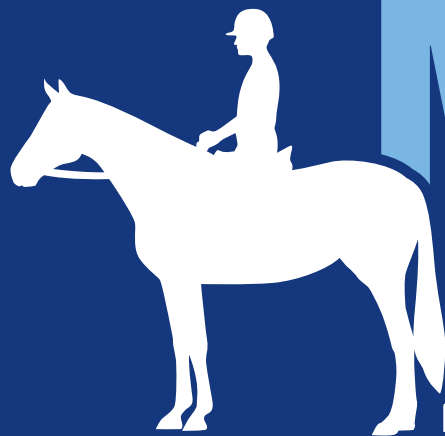

TIES: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. All other ties will be determined by time taken to complete the first round.

MICROCHIP VERIFICATION: All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered. A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal. All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions, Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

SAFE SPORT VERIFICATION: As of January 1, 2019 all USEF members 18-years-old and older, with a Competing Membership, must complete SafeSport Training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions. Please see the USEF website at <https://www.usef.org/compete/resources-forms/rulesregulations/safe-sport> for more information. Those who do not complete the training will be ineligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any USEF Event. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

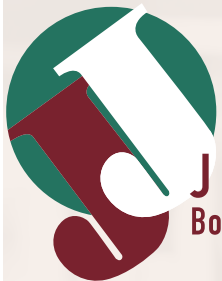
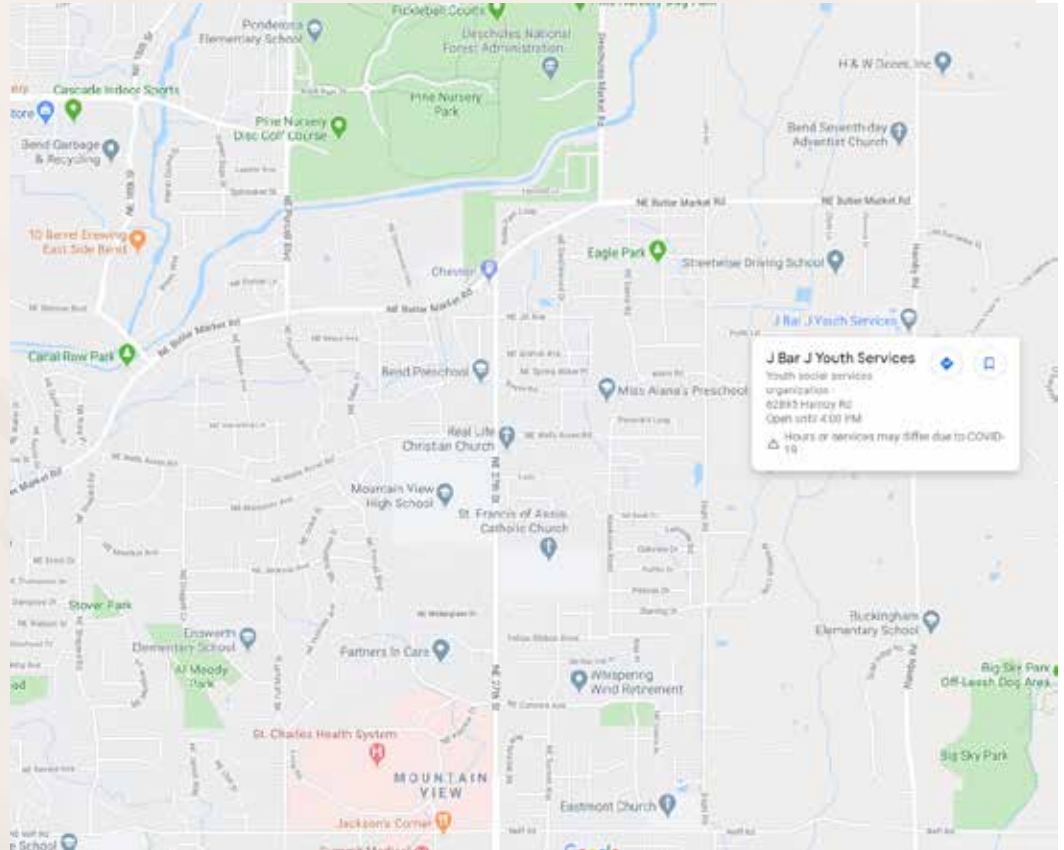

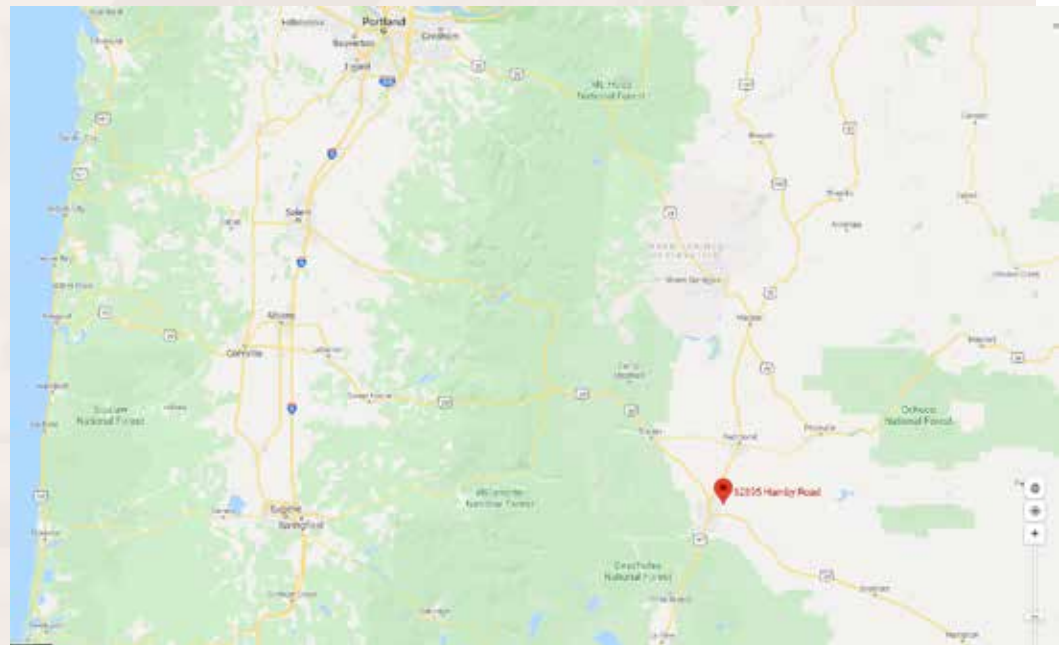
